**32 Count, 4 Wall Intermediate Line Dance**

**Music: "Love Will Keep Us Alive" by The Eagles CD: Hell Freezes Over**

## **Counts and Step Description**

### **Set 1 Rock Forward, Recover Back, Step Back, Drag; Rock Back, Recover Forward, Full Turn Forward**

- 1-4 Rock forward on R, recover back on L, take a big step back on R, slowly drag L heel back for count 4  
5-8 Rock back on L, recover on R, make a full turn traveling forward by turning ½ turn R as you step back on L, make another ½ turn R as you step forward on R

### **Set 2 Rock Forward, Recover, ½ Turn Left, Hold; Rock Forward, Recover, ½ Turn Right, Hold**

- 1-4 Rock forward on L, recover on R, turn ½ turn L, hold (weight on L)  
5-8 Rock forward on R, recover on L, turn ½ turn R, hold (weight on R)

### **Set 3 Side Rock, Recover, Cross Shuffle, Step Side, Behind, Side, ¾ Turn R Sweep**

- 1-2 Rock L to L side, recover on R to R side  
3&4 Cross shuffle L over R by crossing L over R, step R to R side, cross L over R  
5-8 Step R to R side, step L behind R, step R to R side as you turn ¼ turn R, sweep L into ½ turn R (completing ¾ turn) with weight still on R

### **Set 4 Rock Forward, Recover, Rock Back, Recover, Step Forward, ½ Turn Right, Step Forward, Hold**

- 1-4 Rock forward on L, recover on R, rock back on L, recover on R  
5-8 Step forward on L, turn ½ turn R with weight ending forward on R, step forward on L (weight on L), hold

## **Start Again**

**Ending:** To end facing the front, for the last 5 counts of the dance, you will be facing the 9 o'clock wall. Dance the first 4 counts of the dance:

- 1-4 Rock forward on R, recover back on L, take a big step back on R, slowly drag L heel back for count 4  
Count 5: Curl and touch L all the way behind R and slowly unwind ¾ turn L to face the front
